The Linux Foundation is here to help.

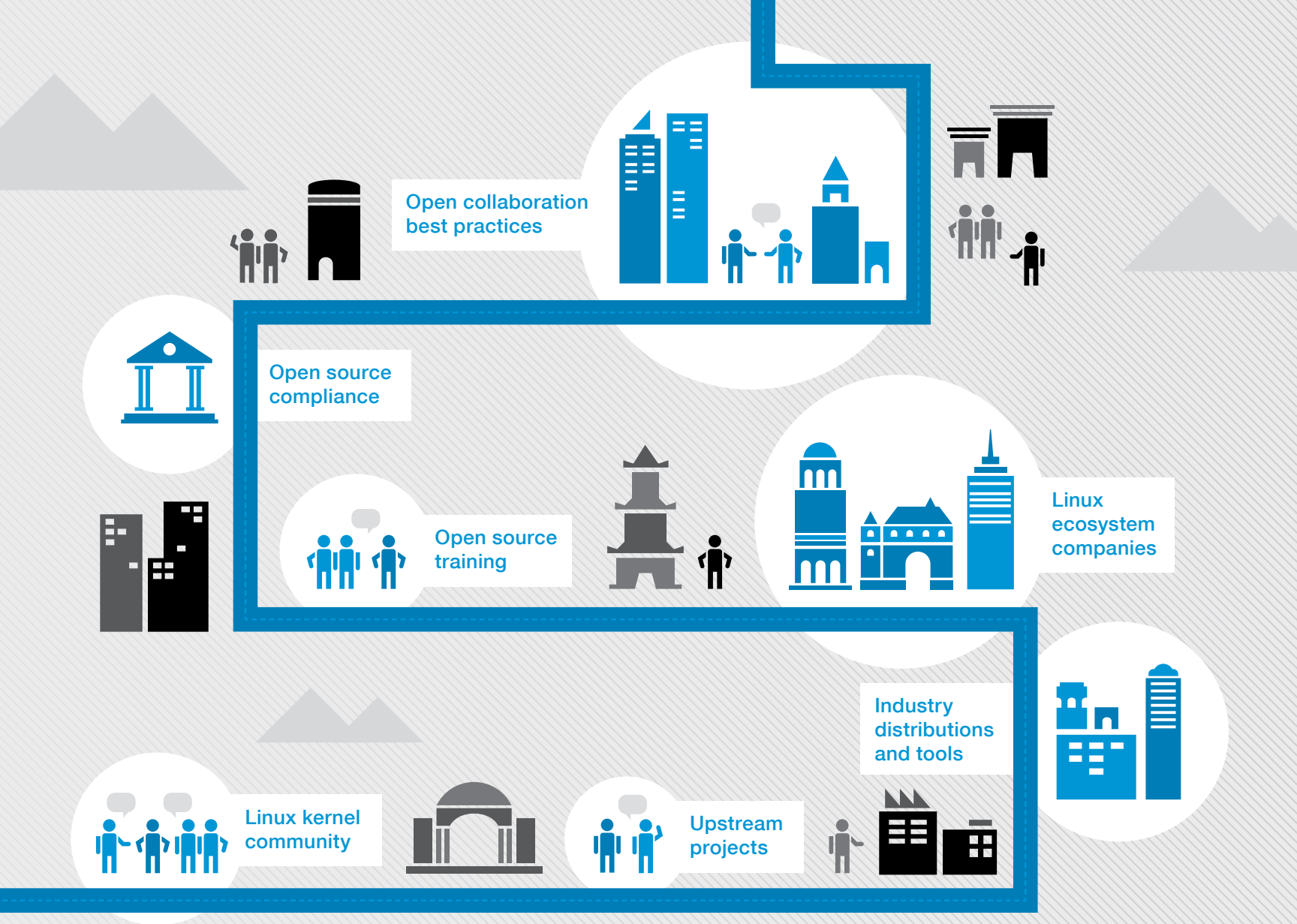
